Manfred Bymoen, 91, New Rockford, died January 3, 2002 in the New Rockford care center. He is survived by his wife, Anna; one son, David, New Rockford; one daughter, Joelyn Scriba, Bemidji, MN and two grandchildren.

Anna Bymoen

Anna Bymoen was born May 6, 1911, near Wellsburg, ND, the daughter of Severin and Agnes (Helgeson) Ekrem. She was raised on the family farm and graduated from Esmond (ND) High School. Anna completed the two year Teaching Standard at Valley City State Teachers College. She then taught school in the area township schools of Valhalla, Bremen, Munster and Manfred and also at Ollie, Montana.

On July 7, 1942, Anna was united in marriage to Manfred Bymoen at Bremen, ND. She was a homemaker when her husband Manfred farmed and was employed by Archie Campbell Road Construction Company. Anna later served as an elementary teacher in the New Rockford school system for many years. She remained active in organizations, including Homemakers, Minerva Club, the Lutheran Home of the Good Shepherd and New Rockford American Legion Auxiliaries, and a variety of First Lutheran Church activities. Anna was proficient in handiwork, she valued friends, and appreciated flowers. Manfred died January 3, 2000.

Anna Bymoen died Friday, June 21, 2002 at the Lutheran Home of the Good Shepherd in New Rockford, ND at the age of 91 years.

She is survived by her son, David Bymoen of New Rockford; daughter Joelyn (Bob) Scriba of Bemidji, MN; one granddaughter Rachel and her fiance Martin Brash; one nephew and five nieces.

Anna was preceded in death by her parents, husband, grandson Kyler Bymoen, brothers Loui, Joel, Sverre and an infant brother, and infant twin grandchildren.
