Alma Dora Nelson, 95, a resident of The Dalles, died Tuesday, September 4, 2007 at her home.

She was born on a homestead on May 27, 1912, the seventh of ten children to Ole and Dorothea (Braaten Skaar in Wells County, North Dakota. Alma was raised in Wells County, and married George Nelson on October 22, 1939 in Fessenden, ND. In 1956 she and George moved the family to Seattle, and in 1989 she moved to The Dalles.
